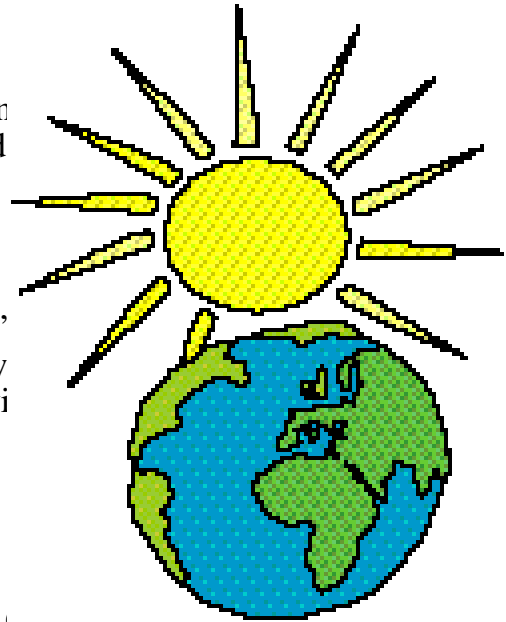


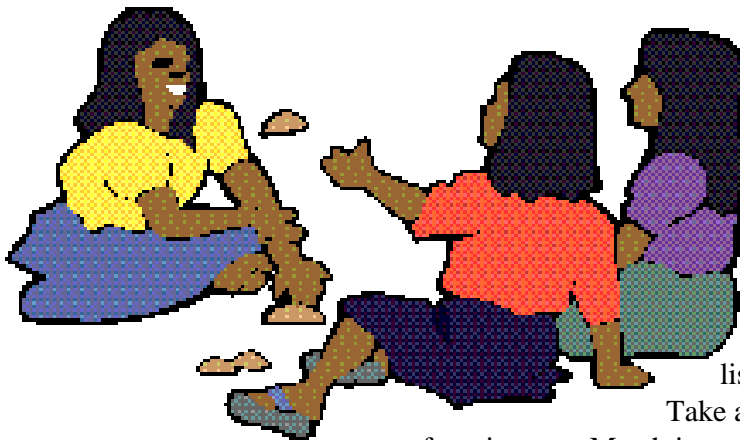
# A Beautiful World

## Know Place Like Home Suggested Activities



### **1. Family Chat:**

#### **Family Album Night**

Take the time to share pictures or videos of each member of the family. Look for family resemblance and differences. Look for traits that make each member special.

### **2. Memory Builder: Family Outing**

Before leaving by foot or in your car, list as many colors as you possibly can.

Take a walk around the neighborhood or to your favorite spot. Match items to your color list. On your way home talk about the beauty of the world around us.

### **3. Refrigerator Art: Handprint Wreath**

Make a family handprint page wreath. Cut a paper grocery bag or a piece of cardboard into a circle. ON a separate sheet of paper trace, color and cut each family members hand enough to fill the wreath. Now paste the hands on the wreath and hang in a prominent spot in your house. Recall your sharing goal and recall the traffic signal when it becomes difficult to keep your eyes on the road.
